

Payson Village Board- Regular Meeting

October 14, 2025

Meeting called to order- Mayor Devers asks for roll call. Village Clerk sworn in. Those present were Chris Devers, Barney Bier, Kristi Shelton, Roger Sunde, Brad Mellon, Chuck Fisher, and Ryan Brinks.

Secretary's Report

Kristi made a motion to accept the secretary's report, seconded by Roger, all approved.

Communications/Guests:

Tim Brown suggested registration for golf carts and side by side vehicles, updating ordinance to charge fee, volunteered to help with registrations. Roger Sunde suggested table until next month, pending research for more information.

Police:

motion to amend the ordinance and fines to a daily fine of \$150, Kristi 2nd, Kristi, Brad, Ryan, and Chuck- yes. Roger- no.

Parks:

Ryan Brinks stated there has only been one quote received for cement around gazebo, will wait to replace tables, benches were replaced.

Financial Committee:

Kristi reported audit has begun, bills report given to board members. Discussion on paying RMA invoice early to receive discount, Kristi made motion to pay, Roger 2nd, all approved.

New Business:

FOIA officer discussed, Barney Bier reported drafting ordinance to name clerk as FOIA officer. Kristi made motion to name clerk as FOIA officer with attorney, Roger 2nd, all approved.
