

Payson Village Board- Regular Meeting June 10th, 2025

Meeting called to order- Mayor Dever asks for roll call. Those present were Chris Dever, Roger Sunde, Kristi Shelton, Chuck Fisher, and Ryan Brinks.

Secretary's Report: Kristi made a motion to accept, and Ryan seconded the motion. All approved.

Communication/Guests: Bob Mitchell, Kathy Crim, Katrina Brown, Jason Perry and Geoffrey with Klingers were guests that were present. Bob was concerned with property cleaning up in his area of town and Chris told him that there was a list of residents that are being followed up on to get cleaned up. Kathy talked about the tombstone clean up that has been going on at the old and new cemeteries and asked the board for a donation to continue with the expenses still needed at both in which Kevin Dunker is doing the work. Roger made a motion to table the issue and to discuss it at next month's meeting and Ryan seconded the motion.

Maintenance Committee:

1. General report: Jason presented an estimate to replace the Toro zero turn mower.
2. Water Tower: Geoffrey updated the board on the water tower schedule which is to start in October on foundation work as weather permits through winter and is to be completed by June-July 2026. Tower color needs to be decided, and samples were handed out to the board. Polar white on the tower with royal blue lettering were the colors that a motion was made by Kristi and seconded by Chuck, all approved.

Police Committee: No new business.

1 Junk yards: Caleb issued a couple of citations for junk in yards and some are repeated citations and those will be addressed. Cars are also being looked at in yards.

Parks Committee:

- 1 General Report: Rob and Ryan will meet with Jason on disc golf equipment that was ordered from a different company at a more reasonable rate.
- 2 Bids were received to remove some trees in the 3 parks plus the new cemetery. The lowest bid was received from Yoder Tree Service for the 15 total trees plus stump removal.

Finance Committee:

- 1 General report: Nothing new to report
- 2 Bills: Motion made to approve by Kristi, seconded by Ryan, and all approved.
- 3 Budget items: Kristi will check on the budget to finish the wash bay on the west side of maintenance building, as well as looking into replacing the fuel tank. Jason asked to meet with the Parks Committee on budget items needed for the parks.
- 4 Barney asked the board to consider a "zoning ordinance" and was decided to discuss and vote on it at the next meeting. This would help control issues such as solar farms, etc.
